

If you do not already have Zoom:

1. Click on the “[Join Zoom](#)” link provided by St. Stephen’s – it will direct you to the Zoom.us page
2. When the install window pops up, click “install.” If it does not pop up, make sure you have enabled pop-ups in your web browser privacy settings (these differ browser-to-browser)
3. You will also be prompted to install a browser plug-in. Just follow the prompts to install.
4. The application will want to test your video and audio capabilities. Follow the prompts for testing. If you want to use a different camera and/or microphone from the one built into your computer or phone, make sure your desired devices are already chosen in your settings.
5. Now you can launch the Zoom app from your computer or phone. In fact, it will automatically launch when you join a meeting. You can do that one of two ways
 - a. Manually enter the meeting ID on the Zoom.us website
 - b. Click on the button or link provided by St. Stephen’s – that will automatically open up Zoom

Alternate method:

1. Go to Zoom.us
2. Look for the button in the upper righthand corner: “Sign up, it’s free!” (It really is, don’t worry)
3. Enter your email address
4. Look for the email from Zoom and click the Activate Account button
5. Enter your details and click “next”
6. You will be prompted to install Zoom. Follow steps 2-5 above.
